Please note that our sport has a "Zero Tolerance" to any kind of unsportsmanlike behaviour. This includes but is not limited to

- Swearing
- Excessive and unnecessary touches
- Referee bantering
- Supporters negative comments

While we understand things don't always go as planned on the field, it is important you consider everyone around you when displaying your frustration.

The Dalby Touch Association enforces this "**Zero Tolerance Policy**". The referees and committee members will be exercising their rights to caution/penalise any player, coach or spectator displaying any sort of unsportsmanlike behaviour. If this type of behaviour is continually displayed, an official warning will be issued both verbally and in written form (this could include suspension).
